Art Gallery of Karlovy Vary has been located at the end of a quiet spa area in an architecturally interesting building of 1912 since 1953. Its collection – making and professional activities are dedicated to Czech art of the 20th-21st centuries. The Gallery has very rich and representative collections of paintings and sculptures – about a hundred art works by top authors of Czech art of the 20th century are presented in three halls of the permanent exhibition. The gallery also organizes short-term exhibitions of contemporary Czech art and foreign authors.

The Becher Villa Interactive Gallery has been located in the newly renovated beautiful interiors of the building adorning the famous Westend residential area since 2011. The gallery's chamber spaces mostly host exhibitions of contemporary Czech art and a large number of accompanying programs for the public, which are held in well-equipped art studios.

Art Gallery of Karlovy Vary has a branch in an early Baroque summer house located in a generously designed castle park in nearby Ostrov. The Summer House was built between 1673 and 1679 and its interiors are decorated with beautiful frescoes. This gallery was founded in 1961 and focused its collection-making activities on Czech drawings and graphics of the 20th century. The exhibition activity is mainly focused on contemporary Czech art.
